### ***Arusha Programs***

- 6 week Spring program: April 9 – May 18 \$2400 (£1540)
- 6 week Summer program I: May 24 – July 6 \$3050 (£1980)

- 6 week Summer program II: July 12 – August 24 \$3050 (£1980)
  - Community-based teachings
  - Teaching in Schools

### ***Zanzibar Programs***

- 4 week program A: May 28 – June 22 \$2500 (£1630)
- 4 week program B: June 25 – July 20 \$2500 (£1630)
- 4 week program C: August 27 – Sept. 21 \$2500 (£1630)

### ***South Africa Programs***

- 4 week Summer program A: May 28 – June 22 \$2800 (£1820)
- 4 week Summer program B: July 16 – August 10 \$2800 (£1820)
- 4 week Summer program C: August 20 – Sept. 14 \$2800 (£1820)

### ***Combination Programs***

- 10 week\* Arusha-Cape Town program: May 24 – August 10 \$5500 (£3580)  
\*Note: This program is held for 6 weeks in Arusha and 4 weeks in Cape Town, consisting of the Arusha 1 program, a 10-day break for personal travel, and the South Africa B program combined.
- 10 week\* Arusha-Zanzibar program: July 12 – September 21 \$5200 (£3390)  
\*Note: This program is held for 6 weeks in Arusha and 4 weeks in Zanzibar, consisting of the Arusha 2 program followed by the Zanzibar C program.
- 10 week\* Fall program: September 10 – November 16 \$4400 (£2870)  
\*Note: This program is held for 5 weeks in Arusha and 5 weeks in Zanzibar.

### ***Application Deadlines***

Prospective volunteers must submit an application by the final deadline:

- **February 15, 2012**

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis – we advise you to apply as early as possible. There are only a certain number of volunteer spaces available in each location each year, and they fill up quickly. Also, applying early allows you to find out the status of your acceptance earlier and therefore have more time to fundraise your program fee and prepare for the program.
